Rules:

1. Online registration for the Education Building will open on August 16, 2018 and close on September 3, 2018 at midnight. **Online registration is highly recommended and will reduce wait times during check in.**
2. ALL exhibits must be entered and/or checked in on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 from 9 am – 7 pm. Flowers/Plants, Horticulture, & Baked Goods **ONLY** may be entered/checked in on Tuesday **or** Wednesday, September 5, 2018 from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 am.
3. All exhibits must be checked in by 11:00 am on Wednesday, September 5, 2018. No late exhibits will be accepted.
4. **Entries must be appropriate for all audiences.**
5. Exhibits entered in the wrong class will be corrected by fair officials before judging.
6. Exhibits must be completed.
7. All articles must be grown by person entering them.
8. All containers, plants, arrangements, and specimens must be cleaned and groomed by the person entering the exhibit.
9. No oiled leaves.
10. Only one plant per pot unless otherwise noted.
11. All materials in arrangements must be grown locally, including dried materials. No artificial materials.
12. Herbs must have a stem 3" long with fresh foliage attached. Use brown bottle for exhibit.
13. Specimens should be no higher than 24" including container and no wider than 12". Use brown bottle for exhibit except for celosia. Celosia should be exhibited in a heavy, non-tipping container.
