Animal Specific Rules (Please see Livestock General Rules for additional Livestock Barn Rules and Regulations)

1. Open to all recognized breeds.
2. Exhibitor must present original registration papers at check-in. Registration papers MUST be in the exhibitor's own name except for crossbred heifers and steers to show in a Registered Class. Animals with invalid registration papers will only be allowed to show in the Commercial Class.
3. Only two (2) animals can be shown in a class by one individual.
4. Those using outside tie-out area must clean up the area.
5. All bulls MUST have a nose ring or nose clip with lead at all times.
6. Prospect & Feeder Steers are not eligible for the Junior Premium Auction.
7. Steers must have all baby teeth and will be inspected at check-in.
8. All stalled cattle must have halter and necktie.
9. Rules & Classes are for both Junior and Open Shows where applicable. Juniors do not compete against Open exhibitors. Exhibitors who qualify as junior exhibitors may only show as junior exhibitors, not open exhibitors.
10. Premiums are paid to junior exhibitors ONLY.
11. Crossbred heifers will be put in classes according to hip-height, not age.
12. Cow/calf pairs may only be shown as a pair. Calf cannot be shown separately.
13. The Junior Premium Auction will be held Friday, September 7, 2018 @ 6:30 pm.

Health Requirements (All beef cattle must meet the following health requirements. If beef cattle do not meet these health requirements they will not be allowed to remain on the fairgrounds.)

1. All animals are subject to inspection by fair officials, veterinarians, and state-federal personnel.
2. No animal showing symptoms of disease will be allowed to enter the fairgrounds.
3. All cattle (except steers) must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within ninety (90) days prior to the fair.
4. All heifers that are four to twelve (4-12) months of age shall be vaccinated before entering the show.

Showmanship Information

1. Showmanship Showdown - Saturday, September 8, 2018 @ 6:00 pm.
2. Showmanship must be registered for separately online in addition to registering your animal.
3. Animals used to compete in the Showmanship Showdown must be owned by the Exhibitor and be an animal the Exhibitor has shown previously in the week.
