The 2018 Conway County Fair Poultry Show is subject to changes and/or cancellation according to directives received by the AR Livestock and Poultry Commission. These are directives beyond the control of the Conway County Fair Board. Changes and/or cancellation could affect all or only parts of the show. Updates will be posted to the Fair website and the Fair Facebook page.

Animal Specific Rules (Please see Livestock General Rules for additional Livestock Barn Rules and Regulations)

1. **The Poultry Show is a JUNIOR ONLY show.**
2. **Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their birds.**
3. All testing must be done prior to the day of the show.
4. Classes are the same for both Junior and Senior Exhibitors.
5. Awards presented in Junior Division only.
6. Conway County Fair Broiler and Turkey Show will be show and go. Auction qualifiers will return on Friday night.
7. The top 25% of broiler pens and the Grand and Reserve poultry chain pens, as determined by the judge, will be eligible for the Junior Premium Auction.
8. The Junior Premium Auction will be held Friday, September 7, 2018 @ 6:30 pm.

Health Requirements (All poultry must meet the following health requirements. If poultry do not meet these health requirements they will not be allowed to enter the fairgrounds.)

1. All animals are subject to inspection by fair officials, veterinarians, and state-federal personnel.
2. No animal showing symptoms of disease will be allowed to enter the fairgrounds.
3. All in-state poultry shall have originated from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Clean or equivalent flocks or have had a negative pullorum-typhoid test within ninety (90) days of the show (pullorum-typhoid testing on fairgrounds during the fair is prohibited). This information will be documented on a NPIP form VS 9-3, 90-Day Certificate, NPIP flock Certification Form or similar certificate that will accompany the poultry at the show. All non-certified birds must be banded (leg or wing band), with a sealed band. Wraparound plastic bands are not acceptable. In-state waterfowl are exempt from pullorum-typhoid requirements.
